ATG is owned by STC - Swedish Trotting Association 90% and SG - Swedish Jockey Club 10%. Of the twelve directors who make up the board, the state appoints six, one of these being the Chairman.</p> <p>ATG is licensed by the Swedish Government to arrange betting on horse racing. The licence regulates the conditions governing betting activities and comes up for renewal at regular intervals.</p>
